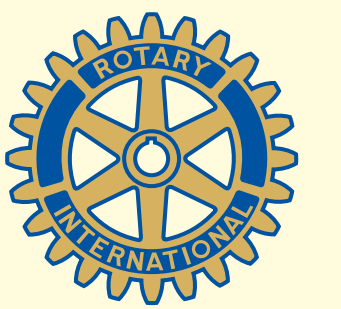

THE PROJECT
